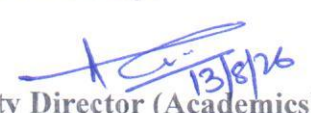
Subject: Clarification/Grant of permission regarding requisite qualifications for engagement of Visiting Faculty in Environmental Engineering – reg.

With reference to your E-mail received in this office on the subject cited above.

In this regard it is intimated that the matter regarding engagement of Visiting Faculty in **Environmental Engineering** has been examined and it is clarified that the engagement of Visiting Faculty shall be made strictly in accordance with the **qualifications prescribed by AICTE for the relevant discipline**, as contained in the applicable AICTE Regulations/Approval Process Handbook and the instructions issued by the State Government from time to time.

2. Since **Environmental Engineering** is generally offered as a specialization under the **Civil Engineering** discipline, the Institute may, after following the prescribed procedure and making due efforts to identify a suitably qualified candidate in Environmental Engineering, consider a candidate possessing the **AICTE-prescribed qualifications in Civil Engineering with appropriate specialization/competency in Environmental Engineering**, subject to fulfilment of all other prescribed eligibility conditions.
3. In case no suitable candidate possessing the prescribed qualifications in **Environmental Engineering** is available despite due advertisement and following the prescribed selection procedure, the Institute is hereby permitted to engage a **Visiting Faculty in Civil Engineering**, possessing the qualifications prescribed by AICTE for the Civil Engineering discipline and having demonstrable competency/appropriate specialization to teach Environmental Engineering, purely as a **temporary academic arrangement for the current academic session**.
4. It is further clarified that such engagement shall be subject to the terms and conditions governing Visiting Faculty, availability of workload, sanctioned approval of the Directorate and other applicable Government/AICTE instructions. The arrangement shall **not create any right or claim for regular appointment** and shall not be treated as a precedent for future engagements.
5. The concerned Principal is, therefore, requested to ensure that the engagement is made strictly in accordance with the prescribed procedure and applicable rules/instructions and that all eligibility documents and records are duly maintained for verification/audit purposes.
